- Parallel structure is using the same pattern of words, phrases, or clauses to show that two or more ideas have the same level of importance. Sentences with parallel structure sound rhythmic and balanced.
- Items in a list or series should be parallel in structure.

EXAMPLE: I am fond of books, music, and films. (three nouns) OR,

I am fond of reading books, listening to music, and watching

films. (three phrases) OR,

I am fond of books, I am fond of music, and I am fond of

films. (three clauses)
